


# **The Surname Book of Tutt**

## Stephen Tutt - 1791

He married Ann Ward (with whom he had 11 children: Edward, Mary, Stephen, Anne, Elizabeth, Sarah, Martha, William, James, Susannah and Joseph) on Aug 27, 1750 in Smeeth, Kent. He died in 1791 in Aldington, Kent and was buried there on Jun 11, 1791 (kFHS CD17).

### Anne Tutt c1756 -

Anne was the child of Stephen Tutt and Ann Ward. She was born in Aldington, Kent, England c. 1756. She was baptized on Dec 25, 1756.

### Edward Tutt c1750 - c1823

Edward was the child of Stephen Tutt and Ann Ward. He was born in Aldington, Kent, England c. 1750. He was baptized on Oct 7, 1750. He died c. 1823 in Aldington and was buried there on Mar 9, 1823 (age 73KFHS CD17).

### Elizabeth Tutt c1759 -

Elizabeth was the child of Stephen Tutt and Ann Ward. She was born in Aldington, Kent, England c. 1759. She was baptized on Mar 11, 1759.

### James Tutt c1770 -

James was the child of Stephen Tutt and Ann Ward. He was born in Aldington, Kent, England c. 1770. He was baptized on Jan 28, 1770.

### Joseph Tutt c1774 - c1846

Joseph was the child of Stephen Tutt and Ann Ward. He was born in Aldington, Kent, England c. 1774. He was baptized on Dec 25, 1774. In 1841, he lived at his birthplace. He died c. 1846 in Willesborough, Kent and was buried in Aldington on Feb 11, 1846 (age 72, died in WillesboroughKFHS CD17).

### Martha Tutt c1764 -

Martha was the child of Stephen Tutt and Ann Ward. She was born in Aldington, Kent, England c. 1764. She was baptized on Aug 5, 1764.

### Mary Tutt c1752 -

Mary was the child of Stephen Tutt and Ann Ward. She was born in Aldington, Kent, England c. 1752. She was baptized on Dec 10, 1752.

### Sarah Tutt c1761 -

Sarah was the child of Stephen Tutt and Ann Ward. She was born in Aldington, Kent, England c. 1761. She was baptized on Dec 13, 1761.

## Stephen Tutt c1754 - 1789

Stephen was the child of Stephen Tutt and Ann Ward. He was born in Smeeth, Kent, England c. 1754. He was baptized in Aldington, Kent, England on Dec 25, 1754 and married Elizabeth Hubbard (with whom he had 6 children: James, Stephen, John, William, Martha and Susanna) there on Aug 9, 1779. He died in Jun 1789 in Aldington and was buried there on Jun 18, 1789 (kFHS CD17).

## Susannah Tutt c1772 -

Susannah was the child of Stephen Tutt and Ann Ward. She was born in Aldington, Kent, England c. 1772. She was baptized on Jul 12, 1772.

## William Tutt c1766 - c1840

William was the child of Stephen Tutt and Ann Ward. He was born in Aldington, Kent, England c. 1766. He was baptized on Dec 28, 1766. He died c. 1840 in Willesborough, Kent (jan/Feb/Mar) and was buried in Aldington on Apr 1, 1840 (aged 73, living in WillesboroughKFHS CD17).

## Grandchildren

### James Tutt c1779 - 1856

James was the child of Stephen Tutt and Elizabeth Hubbard. James was a farm bailiff and laborer. He was born in Mersham, Kent, England c. 1779. He was baptized at St John The Baptist on Oct 31, 1779, and married Sarah Peters, a nurse, (with whom he had 4 children: James, Edmund, Elizabeth and Maria) on Oct 3, 1801 in Folkestone, Kent.

Throughout his life, he lived in Cheriton, Kent in 1841; and at 5 Shortlands Farm, Beckenham, Kent, England on Mar 30, 1851. He died on Apr 18, 1856 Shortlands in Beckenham and was buried at St George in Beckenham on Apr 20, 1856.

### John Tutt 1783 -

John was the child of Stephen Tutt and Elizabeth Hubbard. He was born in Aldington, Kent, England in 1783. He was baptized on Feb 15, 1783.

### Martha Tutt 1787 - 1789

Martha was the child of Stephen Tutt and Elizabeth Hubbard. She was born in Aldington, Kent, England in 1787. She was baptized on Apr 29, 1787. She died in 1789 in Aldington and was buried there on Apr 23, 1789 (kFHS CD17).

### Stephen Tutt 1781 - 1827

Stephen was the child of Stephen Tutt and Elizabeth Hubbard. He was born in Aldington, Kent, England in 1781 and married Mary Peters on Jun 19, 1802 in Folkestone, Kent.

Stephen died in 1827 in Cheriton, Kent.

### Susanna Tutt 1788 -

Susanna was the child of Stephen Tutt and Elizabeth Hubbard. She was born in Aldington, Kent, England in 1788. She was baptized on Nov 9, 1788.

### William Tutt c1785 -

William was the child of Stephen Tutt and Elizabeth Hubbard. He was born in Aldington, Kent, England c. 1785. He was baptized on May 8, 1785.

## Great-grandchildren

### Edmund Tutt c1819 - 1858

Edmund was the child of James Tutt, a farm bailiff, and Sarah Peters, a nurse. Edmund worked as a sawyer. He was born in Cheriton, Kent, England c. 1819. He was baptized at St Martin's Church on Apr 4, 1819, and married Caroline Page, a laundress, (with whom he had 6 children: Eliza, Jane, James, Sarah Maria, Caroline Bromley and Edmund Thomas) on Apr 11, 1847 at Parish Church of St Mary & St Eanswythe, Church Street, Folkestone, Kent (folkestone Parish Church).

During his life, he lived in Folkestone, Kent on Jun 6, 1841; and at 40 George Street, Buckland, Kent on Mar 30, 1851 (was age 32 and the head of the household). He died on Dec 21, 1858 at George Street, Buckland, Kent (obstruction of the bowels 1 week intussusception) and was buried at St Andrew's Church, Buckland on Dec 26, 1858.


## Elizabeth Tutt c1821 - 1828

Elizabeth was the child of James Tutt, a farm bailiff, and Sarah Peters, a nurse. She was born c. 1821. She was baptized at St Martin, Cheriton, Kent, England on Nov 25, 1821.

Elizabeth died in 1828.

## James Tutt c1804 - 1804

James was the child of James Tutt, a farm bailiff, and Sarah Peters, a nurse. He was born c. 1804. He was baptized at St Martin's Church, Cheriton, Kent, England on Apr 22, 1804. He died in 1804 and was buried at St Martin's Church on May 8, 1804.

## Maria Tutt c1825 - c1897

Maria was the child of James Tutt, a farm bailiff, and Sarah Peters, a nurse. She was born in Cheriton, Kent, England c. 1825. She was baptized at St Martin's Church on Mar 6, 1825, and married William Rolfe, an agricultural laborer, (with whom she had 10 children: John, Sarah, Henry, Elizabeth, James, Richard, Maria, William George, Edmund and Susan J) around Nov 1844 in Elham, Kent.

Maria spent all of her life in Kent, England. Throughout her life, she lived in several places around the county: in Brookland on Jun 6, 1841 (was age 17); at Cheriton Street in Cheriton on Mar 30, 1851 (was age 26 and the wife of the head of the household); at Horn Street in Cheriton on Apr 7, 1861 (was age 37, the wife of the head of the household) (when she was living with her mother, Sarah), in 1871 (the same place as her mother had been living on Apr 7, 1861), on Apr 2, 1871 (was age 46, the wife of the head of the household) and on Apr 3, 1881 (was age 56 and the wife of the head of the household); and on Sandgate Road, Hythe on Apr 5, 1891 (was age 66 and a visitor in the household). She died c. Jul 1897 in Elham, Kent and was buried in Cheriton on Jul 4, 1897.

**COUNTY PETTY SESSIONS, THURSDAY.**—Before the Rev. E. Biron and John Kirkpatrick, Esq.—John Smith, on remand, pleaded "guilty" to stealing a jacket, and was sentenced to one month's hard labour.—William Browning was charged with embezzling money belonging to his master, Mr. Frederick Franklin, baker, Sandgate. Mr. Franklin deposed: I am a baker living at Sandgate. Prisoner has been in my employ as a journeyman about two months. His duty was to account for money received every evening. On September 28th last I received no money from the prisoner, and on the following week, October 4th, I sent an account to a Mrs. Rolfe. I afterwards went and saw her. On October 1st I discharged the prisoner, as he came home drunk. Maria Rolfe, wife of William Rolfe, labourer, Hornstreet, Cheriton: I deal with Mr. Franklin. On September 28th I paid the prisoner 5s. 6½d. I had no receipt. I afterwards received an account from Mr. Franklin.—Prisoner pleaded "guilty," and was sent to St. Augustine's for one calendar month with hard labour.

## Great-great-grandchildren

### Caroline Bromley Tutt cMay 1857 - c1889

Caroline was the child of Edmund Tutt, a sawyer, and Caroline Page, a laundress. She was born in Buckland, Kent, England c. May 1857. She was baptized at St Andrew's Church on Mar 13, 1858 and married John Butler on Oct 14, 1878 in Hammersmith, London (oct/Nov/Dec). She had 1 child, James Edmund Stephen Thomas, whose father is unknown.

Throughout her life, Caroline lived in several places: at Shooter's Hill in Buckland on Apr 7, 1861 (was age 3 and the daughter of the head of the household); in Smeeth, Kent in 1871; and in Gillingham, Kent in 1881 (marital Status: Married Relation to Head of House: Head).

Caroline died c. Feb 1889 in Dover, Kent.

### Edmund Thomas Tutt cAug 1859 - 1860


Edmund was the child of Edmund Tutt, a sawyer, and Caroline Page, a laundress. He was born in Dover, Kent, England c. Aug 1859. He was baptized at St Andrew's Church, Buckland, Kent, England on Feb 26, 1860. He died on Dec 24, 1860 on George Street, Buckland, Kent (hydrocephalus (water on the brain)) and was buried at St Andrew's Church, Buckland on Dec 30, 1860.

### Eliza Tutt 1847 - c1930

Eliza was the daughter of Edmund Tutt, a sawyer, and Caroline Page, a laundress. Eliza worked as a general servant. She was born in Buckland, Kent, England on Sep 15, 1847. She was baptized at St Andrew's Church on Apr 16, 1848, and married Thomas Tunbridge, a dairyman, (with whom she had 5 children: Harry, Lily, Frank, Walter and Albert) on Aug 22, 1874 in St Lawrence, Thanet, Kent (jul/Aug/Sep).

Eliza spent all of her life in Kent, England. Throughout her life, she lived in several places around the county: at 40 George Street in Buckland on Mar 30, 1851 (was age 3 and the daughter of the head of the household); at Shooter's Hill in Buckland on Apr 7, 1861 (was age 13 and the daughter of the head of the household); in Dover in 1871 (relation to Head of House: Servant); in Hougham in 1881 (relation to Head of House: Wife; Marital Status: Married); at 9 Elms Cottage, Hougham on Apr 5, 1891 (was age 42 and the wife of the head of the household); and at 5 Eaton Road, Dover on Mar 31, 1901 (was age 52, the wife of the head of the household) and on Apr 2, 1911 (was age 63 and the wife of the head of the household).

Eliza died c. May 1930 in Dover, Kent.

## James Tutt 1851 - 1915

James was the son of Edmund Tutt, a sawyer, and Caroline Page, a laundress. James worked as a general laborer. He was born in Dover, Kent, England on Jan 16, 1851, and married Jane Foord, a general shop, (with whom he had 8 children: Jane Eliza Caroline, James Richard Edmund, Jessie Maria, Edmund Thomas, Lily, Harriet, Rose Elizabeth and Frank) on Apr 29, 1876 at St Lawrence Parish Church, St Lawrence, Thanet, Kent (kFHS CD 29).

James spent all of his life in Kent, England. Throughout his life, he lived in several places around the county: at 40 George Street, Buckland on Mar 30, 1851 (was age 0 and the son of the head of the household), when he was living with his sister, Eliza; at 13 Shooter's Hill, Buckland on Apr 7, 1861 (was age 9 and the son of the head of the household); at 18 Clarence Terrace, Ramsgate on Apr 3, 1881 (was age 30 and the head of the household); at 10 Clarence Road, Ramsgate on Apr 5, 1891 (was age 40 and the head of the household); at 8 Hillbrow Road, St Lawrence, Thanet on Mar 31, 1901 (was age 50 and the head of the household); and at 7 Hillbrow Road, St Lawrence, Thanet on Apr 2, 1911 (was age 60 and the head of the household) which is where he died on Dec 18, 1915 ((1) Asthma Chronic 20 years; (2) Bronchitis Catarrhal).

## Jane Tutt 1849 - 1909

Jane was the daughter of Edmund Tutt, a sawyer, and Caroline Page, a laundress. Jane worked as a laundress. She was born in Buckland, Kent, England on May 12, 1849, and married Charles Horne, a waggoner on a farm, (with whom she had 3 children: Charles Henry, Isaac and Edmund) on Jun 9, 1883 at Mount Ephraim Baptist Chapel, Margate, Kent (mount Ephraim Chapel).

Jane spent all of her life in Kent, England. Throughout her life, she lived in several places around the county: at 40 George Street in Buckland on Mar 30, 1851 (was age 1 and the daughter of the head of the household), when she was living with her brother James and sister Eliza; at 13 Shooter's Hill in Buckland on Apr 7, 1861 (was age 11 and the daughter of the head of the household); at 7 Market Place, Dover on Apr 2, 1871 (servant, aged 21); at 18 Clarence Terrace, St Lawrence, Thanet on Apr 3, 1881 (was age 31 and the daughter of the head of the household) (when she was living with her mother, Caroline Bromley); at Drapers Cottage, Margate on Apr 5, 1891; and at 15 Haine Cottages, St Lawrence, Thanet on Mar 31, 1901. She died on Jun 7, 1909 at 4 Convent Cottages, Reading Street, St Peters, Thanet, Kent (chronic heart disease) and was buried there on Jun 11, 1909.






